ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. — Klan and other white supremacist groups. He has been brutally beaten by the KKK and white night raiders have raked his home with shotgun blasts.

Negro leaders have asked President Johnson "that the money be withheld until the town corrects its racial abuses."
