**DEAR DEPRESSED:** This society has kept our men in a status inferior to that of our women. Job opportunities aren't as good and wages are so low that the man must have his wife's help, though he may resent it.

Your husband probably is aware of his responsibilities and of the fact that he needs your help. His resentment is manifest in the statements he makes.

If you understand him, you will be able to find ways to build him up. Try to make

him feel that he is necessary and important to you. Do a few extra things just for him — then watch his response.

Don't feel like your problem is an isolated case. It is created by the circumstances under which we live. We, as women, must do our part to see that our men feel like men.

**DEAR HARRIETT:** I have run all over Chicago looking for work, but all I can find requires living in the homes of white families. Being employed in this manner keeps me a way from religious services.

I have a friend whom I don't love and with whom I can't see any future, but he has been helping me.

There is another man in another city, working so that he can return and open a

store for us. I love this man, but he told me he isn't going to marry me until I break off with this other man.

Tell me what to do.

**DEAR ANXIOUS:** The fact that you work in the home of a white family should not keep you from putting forth a special effort to attend your religious services. There are many other women similarly employed who manage quite well.

As for the two men in your life—you have no real problem. You say there is no future with one man and you do not love him. Tell this man the facts, letting him know you appreciate his help, but that you are making plans to marry. This will qualify you for the man you love.
