Question: Do you feel you have reached this condition?

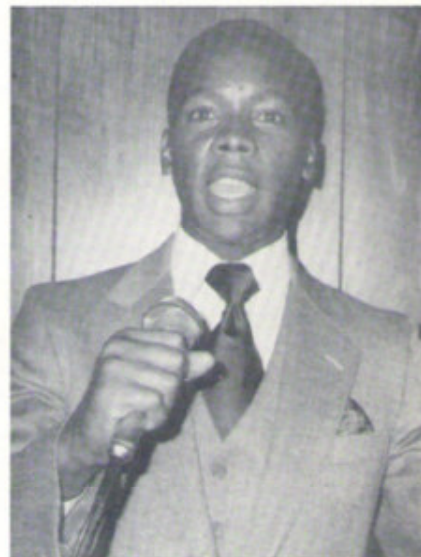
